



Counterfeit, Fraudulent and Suspect Items Policy

At Truturn Precision Engineering (Charfield) Limited safety is our overriding priority and we understand the potential risks concerning the supply of Counterfeit, Fraudulent and Suspect Items (CFSI) within the supply chain, and to this end we only use suppliers that can demonstrate the quality and source of the materials (including goods) that we require.

Counterfeit, Fraudulent and Suspect Items are those whose age, composition, configuration, certification, or any other characteristics that are different to those of authentic goods, however, are still represented as original. The following list describes some of the ways that Counterfeit, Fraudulent and Suspect Items, or suppliers of them may be identified:

- Shorter lead times than other suppliers
- Sudden availability of obsolete or hard to source material or goods.
- Cheaper than expected prices.
- Misleading marking of material, labelling or packaging.
- Misleading documentation.
- Any other means, including failing to disclose information.

Truturn Precision Engineering (Charfield) Ltd is committed to preventing such items from getting into their processes.

All Truturn Precision Engineering (Charfield) Ltd employees involved in the purchasing of materials have been informed of the potential for CFSI and advised that all materials must be purchased from suppliers evaluated and approved in line with company procedure OP15 Purchasing & Procurement including Supplier Assessment.

Materials are purchased to agreed specification, incoming product is checked against the purchasing specification, certification is supplied with incoming material as requested. Material is identified and sorted in accordance with customer requirements and Truturn Precision Engineering (Charfield) Ltd quality procedures. We maintain procedures and audit compliance with ISO9001:2015.

If any CFSI items are discovered, we will notify our customers immediately so that they may cease the use of this item and inform any other parties which may be using them. Items will be quarantined and destroyed (or otherwise rendered unusable), to prevent materials from re-entering the supply chain.
